



Injury Policy

Adopted by Southern Highlands Netball Association Inc.

- i The Competition Coordinator is to ensure an Injury Report form is provided with each score board at the beginning of competition days.
- ii In the event of an Injury Report form being used the scorer on the game must replace it with a new Injury Report form so that there is always one courtside during play. Replacement forms can be obtained from the clubhouse.
- iii If an injury occurs it is the responsibility of the scorer to remind the umpire to complete the Injury Report at the conclusion of the game.
- iv Once the umpire has completed the Injury Report they then return it to the Competition Coordinator at the clubhouse. It is essential that the form is handed to the Competition Coordinator or another Executive Member to ensure all required information has been obtained.
- v In the event of an injured player being taken to hospital during the game it is the umpires' responsibility to delegate an appropriate adult to gather relevant information before the player leaves the grounds.
- vi In the event of a player not being able to answer the questions it is the umpires' responsibility to ensure that the Competition Coordinator is advised of the injury. They will then follow up with the injured player to complete the Injury Report.
- vii The injured player can access the required insurance paperwork via the Southern Highlands Netball Association website.
